The mountain pathways are a network of pedestrian routes that, due to the range and diversity of places covered, represent one of the most enriching ways of discovering the region.

The Fervenca route begins in Sabugueiro, passing through a typical mountainous landscape. In the village, the traditions and customs related with pastoral activity remain deeply rooted in daily life.



The Fervenca route develops in the surroundings of the village of Sabugueiro in a rugged area crossed by the Covão do Urso and Fervenca

The landscape is dominated by pine trees, hay meadows, heather and broom scrublands. In the Covão do Urso, a depression shaped by the action of glaciers, several sedimentary deposits, whose materials were carried by ice during the last cold period, are evident.

Near to the *Cabeco da Carnezeda*, at the top of the slope, the waters of the Fervença stream plunge into a waterfall, providing from this location an ample view over the valley and the village. Downstream, at the confluence of this stream with the Cabaco stream, the abundance of water keeps the meadows green all year and there is also a picturesque bridge.


